**CASES AWAITING PLACEMENT**

**KH (18-1116983)**

In April 2017, the minor child was placed in a Family Learning Home by Juvenile Services due to attempted sexual assault of his younger sister. In July, he was moved to a treatment level foster home. WCHSA was informed in March 2018 that the minor child's funding would discontinue. His father, the sole caretaker, has not engaged in services or regularly attended visitation. The children need an attorney to represent their wishes and legal interests regarding placement, permanency, and visitation and to ensure the proper services are in place. There is a 12-month Permanency Hearing on March 12, 2019 at 11:20am in Department 14. This is a PROJECT ONE case and will involve delinquency and dependency issues. ***WLS has a conflict and cannot provide direct mentoring or guidance on this case. You can be referred to LACSN for assistance if you have case specific questions. We currently represent the sister and alleged victim in this case.***

**MH (18-1119235)**

The minor child is currently ten years old, and came into care in 2014. Mother relinquished her parental rights in June 2017, and the minor child's father is deceased. The minor has had significant trauma and is reported to have significant behavioral problems. She is in a treatment-level foster home and the permanency plan is adoption. There is a 54-month Review Hearing set on December 20, 2018, at 9:40 a.m. in JM1. ***WLS has a conflict and cannot provide direct mentoring or guidance on this case. You can be referred to LACSN for assistance if you have case specific questions. A WLS attorney has been the foster placement for this client in the past.***

**KD and SC (18-1121486 and 18-1121487)**

A two and one year old came into care in September 2018 because their mother was taken to the ER for strangulation by alleged father (DNA testing has ruled him out as father for one child). The father is currently on the run. Mother is homeless. The children are placed together in a family foster home. There is an evidentiary hearing on December 10, 2018 from 9:00am to 12:00pm in JM1. ***WLS has a conflict and cannot provide direct mentoring or guidance on this case. You can be referred to LACSN for assistance if you have case specific questions. A WLS attorney has represented the mother in the past.***

**RJ (18-1120581)**

The minor came into care in October 2012, and he is now 8 years old. Both his parents' rights have been terminated. He is at an adoptive placement with his maternal aunt and uncle in Utah, however his half sibling has expressed concerns about his placement, and the siblings are not placed together. There is a 76-month Review Hearing on March 27, 2019 at 10:40am in JM1. ***WLS has a conflict and cannot provide direct mentoring or guidance on this case. You can be referred to LACSN for***

**JM (18-1120867)**

The minor came into care in June 2018 from the hospital. The mother did not have baby supplies and stated she wasn't ready to be a mom. The parents' whereabouts are currently unknown. The minor infant is placed with fictive kin. There will be a six-month review hearing on April 11, 2019 at 2:20pm in JM1. *WLS has a conflict and cannot provide direct mentoring or guidance on this case. You can be referred to LACSN for assistance if you have case specific questions. A WLS attorney has represented the mother in the past.*

**TN (18-1115555)**

The minor child came into care in January 2016, and he is now 7 years old. Both his parents have relinquished their parental rights. There are some behavioral concerns with his hyperactivity and boundary-pushing. An ICPC to a different family foster home in Clark County has been requested. There is a 36-month Permanency Hearing on January 24, 2019 at 10am in JM1.
